SUBJECT: **CALIFORNIA INCIDENT COMMAND CERTIFICATION SYSTEM (CICCS)
CERTIFICATION/QUALIFICATION**

Attached is a list of your agency's personnel currently entered into the Incident Qualification System (IQS). Also attached is the 2022 IQS Agency Update Letter. This document and current XST Position Tasksheets are available on our website <http://www.stanoes.com/ciccs.shtm>.

To streamline the yearly CICCS position qualification update into IQS, please review your department's roster and perform the following:

*Personnel who have not promoted or changed positions: Sign the attached XST 2022 IQS Agency Update Letter stating that your personnel have met RT-130 (Annual Fireline Safety Refresher) and the arduous fitness standard for 2022 and **indicate the date of your agency's annual RT-130 Refresher**. You do not need to recreate a new XST Tasksheet if these individuals have not promoted or changed positions.

*Personnel who have promoted or changed positions: On the IQS Qualifications Roster, enter the updated information in the change column for the individuals, then complete and return a signed XST Tasksheet for their new position. Please send copies of all supporting certification and documentation with the Position Taskbook for filing at the Fire Warden's Office.

*New personnel to your agency: Write the new personnel's name on the roster, then complete and return a signed XST Tasksheet for those individuals. Please send copies of all supporting certification and documentation with the Position Taskbook for filing at the Fire Warden's Office.

*Personnel who are no longer affiliated with your department: On the IQS Qualifications Roster, indicate **Remove** in the change column for the individuals.

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Once we have received the signed XST 2022 IQS Agency Update Letter for personnel who have not promoted or changed positions, the new XST Tasksheets for personnel who have promoted or changed positions, the XST Tasksheets for new personnel, and the updated IQS Qualifications roster, we will update our IQS database in preparation for the 2022 Fire Season. Your department will then be issued incident qualification cards (Red Cards) for all personnel who have met CICCS qualification standards.
